

RULES AND REGULATIONS
OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES
FOR
THE ESTABLISHMENT AND ADMINISTRATION
OF RIGHT-OF-WAY WIDTHS AND SETBACK LINES
FOR PLANNED STREET AND PUBLIC TRANSIT IMPROVEMENTS

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY

Pursuant to Sections 6-1102(a), 6-1102(c) and 6-1102(e), City Charter, and Chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, these Rules and Regulations hereinafter contained are hereby established.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of these Rules and Regulations is to implement the Development Plan requirements for the Director to establish and administer right-of-way widths and setback lines for planned street and public transit improvements shown in the Public Facilities Maps as well as for planned improvements to minor streets.

SECTION 3. SCOPE

These Rules and Regulations shall apply to the following Development Plan areas within the City and County of Honolulu:

- Primary Urban Center
- Ewa

Unless otherwise determined by the Director, all improvements on property abutting or having access to public streets, shall respect the street setback requirements established by these Rules and Regulations.

SECTION 4. ADMINISTRATION

The Director shall administer the provisions of these Rules and Regulations in consultation with other appropriate governmental agencies.

SECTION 5. DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of these Rules, unless it is plainly evident from the context that a different meaning is intended, words and phrases used herein are defined as follows:

- a. "Bikeway" is as defined in Chapter 15 of R.O. 1969, as amended.
- b. "Building" means Building Department of the City and County of Honolulu.
- c. "City" means the City and County of Honolulu, whose geographical limits include the Island of Oahu and all other islands in the State of Hawaii, not included in any other county and the waters adjacent thereto.
- d. "City Charter" means the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu, 1973, as amended.
- e. "Department" means the Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu, unless otherwise specified.
- f. "Development Plan(s)" is as defined in the City Charter.
- g. "Director" means the Director of Transportation Services, City and County of Honolulu, unless otherwise specified.
- h. "General Plan" is as defined in the City Charter.
- i. "General Planning" means the Department of General Planning of the City and County of Honolulu.
- j. "Land Use" is as defined in Section 3, Attachment I of the adopted Development Plan Ordinances.
- k. "Land Utilization" means the Department of Land Utilization of the City and County of Honolulu.
- l. "Planning Area Maps" mean maps of various areas within the City and County of Honolulu reflecting right-of-way and setback requirements for streets and highways which are hereby incorporated by reference in these Rules and Regulations.

- m. "Public Facilities Map" means the map which shows proposed public facility improvements within a particular area covered by an adopted Development Plan.
- n. "Public Transit" means a mode of public transportation to move large numbers of people.
- o. "Setback" means a future right-of-way line for a street or highway.
- p. "Street" means any public or private right-of-way primarily used for vehicular use and pedestrian movement.

"Major Street" includes arterials and collector streets. An arterial is a street of considerable continuity which can carry a large volume of traffic and is used primarily as a route between communities, large urban areas, or from one section of the City to another. A collector is a street which carries or collects traffic from minor streets either directly or via other collector streets. All major streets in the PUC and Ewa Development Plan areas are listed in Attachment "A".

"Minor Street" means a local street or a street other than a major street providing access to property and serving local traffic only. All streets in the PUC and Ewa Development Plan areas not listed in Attachment "A" are classified as minor streets. Attachment "B" lists all minor streets proposed for future improvements.

SECTION 6. WHERE INFORMATION MAY BE OBTAINED BY THE PUBLIC

6.1 Location

The Public may obtain information as to matters within the jurisdiction of the Department which are classified as matters of public information pursuant to Section 91-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, or public records under Section 92-50, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and Section 6-1102, City Charter, by inquiring at:

- a. The Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, where there are on file all Rules and Regulations of the Department; or

- b. The Department of Transportation Services, City and County of Honolulu, 650 South King Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813. Copies of compilations of these Rules and Regulations and supplements thereto will be made available to the public at a price to be fixed by the Department to cover mailing and publication costs.

6.2 Submittals or Requests for Information

Such inquiry may be made in person at the Department during business hours or by submitting a request for information in writing to the Director.

SECTION 7. PETITION FOR ADOPTION, AMENDMENT, OR
REPEAL OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

7.1 Petition

Any interested person or public agency may petition the Department requesting the adoption, amendment, or repeal of any section or provision of these Rules and Regulations.

7.2 Submission

The petition shall be submitted in ten (10) copies to the Director, Department of Transportation Services, City and County of Honolulu, 650 South King Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813. It shall include:

- a. A statement of the nature of the petitioner's interest.
- b. A draft or the substance of the proposed rule or amendment or a designation of the provision sought to be repealed.
- c. An explicit statement of the reasons in support of the proposed rule, amendment, or repeal.

7.3 Disposition of Petition

The Department shall within thirty (30) days after the submission of the petition either reject the petition in writing, stating its reasons for such rejection or initiated proceedings in accordance with Section 91-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for the adoption, amendment, or repeal of the Rules, as the case may be.

SECTION 8. DECLARATORY RULINGS BY THE DEPARTMENT

8.1 Petition

Any interested person may petition the Department for a declaratory order as to the applicability of any statute or ordinance relating to the Department, or of any rule or order of the Department, in accordance with Section 91-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

8.2 Submission of Petition

The petition shall be submitted in duplicate and it shall include:

- a. The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner.
- b. A statement of the nature of petitioner's interest, including reasons for the submission of the petition.
- c. A designation of the specific provision, rule, or order in question.
- d. A complete statement of facts.
- e. A statement of the position or contention of the petitioner.
- f. A memorandum of authorities, containing a full discussion of the reasons, including any legal authorities, in support of such position or contention.

8.3 Rejection of Petition

Any petition which does not conform to the foregoing requirements may be rejected.

8.4 Refusal to Issue Declaratory Ruling

The Department may for good cause refuse to issue a declaratory ruling. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Department may so refuse where:

- a. The question is speculative or purely hypothetical and does not involve existing fact or facts which can reasonably be expected to exist in the near future.

- b. The petitioner's interest is not of the type which would give him standing to maintain an action if he were to seek judicial relief.
- c. The issuance of the declaratory ruling may adversely affect the interests of the City, the Department, or any of their officers or employees in any litigation which is pending or may reasonably be expected to arise.
- d. The matter is not within the jurisdiction of the Department.

8.5 Referral to Other Agencies

Where any question of law is involved, the Department may refer the matter to the Corporation Counsel. The Department may also obtain the assistance of other agencies, where necessary or desirable.

8.6 Notification of Petitioner

Upon the disposition of his petition, the petitioner shall be promptly informed thereof by the Director.

8.7 Status of Decisions

Orders disposing of petitions shall have the same status as other orders of the Department. Decisions shall be applicable only to the fact situation alleged in the petition or set forth in the decision. They shall not be applicable to different fact situations or where additional facts not considered in the decision exist.

SECTION 9. RIGHT-OF-WAY AND SETBACK REQUIREMENTS

9.1 Establishment of Right-of-Way and Setback Requirements

The Director hereby establishes proposed right-of-way widths and street setback lines for (i) planned street improvements shown on the Public Facilities Maps, (ii) public transit improvements, and (iii) minor streets. The right-of-way widths and street setback lines hereby established are based upon the Development Plan land uses for the respective areas covered by said Development Plans and the standards set forth in the Subdivision Rules and Regulations of the City.

9.2 Specific Right-of-Way and Setback Requirements

Proposed right-of-way widths and street setback lines are hereby established by the Director as follows:

a. Major Streets.

For planned street improvements shown on the Public Facilities Map (Major Streets) and listed in Attachment "A", according to the Planning Area Maps, dated JULY 28, 1983, as amended, on display at the Department of Land Utilization and Building Department, Honolulu Municipal Building, 650 South King Street, Honolulu, Hawaii, and incorporated herein by reference. Attachment "A" lists all major streets in the PUC and Ewa Development Plan areas; those streets planned for future improvements and shown on the public facilities map are indicated with an asterisk.

b. Minor Streets.

For those minor streets shown in Attachment "B", according to the Planning Area Maps, dated JULY 28, 1983, as amended, on display at the Department of Land Utilization and Building Department, Honolulu Municipal Building, 650 South King Street, Honolulu, Hawaii, and incorporated herein by reference.

c. Public Transit.

(NOTE: Requirements for the Honolulu Area Rapid Transit (HART) system alignment shown on the Public Facilities Map have not been finalized.)

9.3 Corner Roundings At Street Intersections

Requirements for corner roundings at street intersections will be based upon the appropriate design standards as shown in the Department of Transportation Services' Traffic Standards Manual, July, 1976.

9.4 Planning Area Maps; Clarification

Except as hereinafter provided, modifications to the Planning Area Maps shall be made pursuant to the Administrative Authority set forth in Section 9.5 below. As necessary or upon the written request of any interested person, the Director may do the following: (a) Clarify the width of a proposed right-of-way or location of a street setback line when the proposed right-of-way width or street setback line cannot be determined accurately from the

Planning Area Maps; or (b) Reduce a proposed right-of-way width shown on the Planning Area Map when it is impracticable to require the entire proposed right-of-way width. Requests by interested persons shall conform to the procedures set forth in Section 8 hereof for declaratory rulings. The determination of the Director shall be in writing and shall have the same status as other orders of the Department. A copy of the Director's decision shall be mailed to the petitioner and interested agencies.

9.5 Administrative Authority

Pursuant to the amendment procedures established in Section 7, the Director shall have the authority to make modifications to the street right-of-way and setback requirements, and to make the appropriate revisions to the Planning Area Maps established by these Rules and Regulations as authorized by law, including, but not limited to:

a. Major Streets.

- (1) Modify street right-of-way and setback requirements provided that the change does not conflict with the improvements as reflected on the Public Facilities Maps.
- (2) Establish new or delete existing street right-of-way and setback requirements following the enactment of an amendment which deletes or adds such a street or planned improvement on the Development Plan with respect to the street.
- (3) Close or abandon an existing street in accordance with the provisions of Sections 264-1 and 264-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, pursuant to the enactment of an amendment to the Development Plan with respect to the street.
- (4) Modify street right-of-way width as required to provide for a bikeway.

b. Minor Streets.

- (1) Reduce, increase, establish new, or delete existing street right-of-way and setback requirements.
- (2) Adjust the location or alignment of a planned street improvement.

- (3) Close or abandon an existing street in accordance with the provisions of Sections 264-1 and 264-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, pursuant to the enactment of an amendment to the Development Plan with respect to the street.
- (4) Modify street right-of-way width as required to provide for a bikeway.

9.6 Amendment to Development Plans

All amendments to planned street improvements shown on the Public Facilities Maps (Major Streets), and all major or minor street deletions shall be processed in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Development Plan ordinances, and the "Rules of the Department of General Planning for Processing Amendments to the Development Plans of the City and County of Honolulu." Appropriate right-of-way widths and setbacks shall be established by the Director within 120 days of the enactment of such amendment.

SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY

If any section or provision of these Rules is held to be invalid for any reason whatsoever, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections or provisions of these Rules which can be given effect with the invalid section or provision.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE OF THESE RULES

These Rules shall become effective upon their approval by the Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu.


