Kahala WWPS pipe repair, Waialae Beach Park parking lot closed

HONOLULU – The city's Department of Environmental Services responded yesterday to an influent pipe break at the Kahala Wastewater Pump Station. Residents from Niu Valley to the Waialae Golf Course are asked to limit water use at this time.

The Department of Design and Construction is overseeing the project with a private contractor assisting with the repairs. Due to large trucks in the area, the Waialae Beach Park parking lot is closed to the public for the next 5-7 days during the repair operations.

Vactor trucks are set up on Kahala Avenue and at the pump station to capture flow and divert it down stream of the WWPS while a bypass pipe is installed.

No wastewater has reached receiving water at this time.
