ENV responding to force main break, asks Ko Olina residents to conserve water

KAPOLEI – The city’s Department of Environmental Services is responding to a force main break at its West Beach Wastewater Pump Station in Ko Olina and is asking residents and local businesses in the area to conserve water.

Water users are asked to minimize use of toilets, sinks, dishwashers, washing machines and showers.

ENV crews are utilizing tanker, Vactor and cesspool trucks to capture as much of the flow upstream and redistribute it downstream.

ENV will be working with the Department of Design and Construction to hire an emergency third party contractor to repair the pipe.

ENV notified the state Department of Health. Warning sign posting and water sampling have been initiated.
