Advisory Opinion No. 31

This is in response to your written request dated March 1, 1972, for our advice on whether or not it would be permissible for you to apply for a part-time job as a tour conductor with a travel agency. We understand that you are presently employed with the Division of Land Survey and Acquisition, Department of Public Works, as a Land Acquisition Officer.

The Ethics Commission ruled no conflict of interest in the instant case. As a caveat, however, we request that you do not solicit any business from your subordinates.
