



No one wants to be in a fire. But if this should happen, this activity book will be of great help.




Parent Hint: Remind your child that under all of this protective clothing is a helpful firefighter. Go to him in an emergency.










A Brush Fire has burned this area. Color this page

Parent Hints: These two pages show what an area may look like before and after a brush fire one of the leading types of fire in the state. Be especially careful during the hot, dry summer months.




