- §3-71-1 Purpose.**
The purpose of this section is to set the City's service fee for a Dishonored check. [Eff 10/31/2004] (Auth: ROH §2-4.2(b); RCH §4-105) (Imp: ROH §2-4.2(b))
- §3-71-2 Definitions.**
(a) "Director" Refers to the Director of the Department of Budget and Fiscal Services of the City and County of Honolulu.
(b) "Dishonored Check" Refers to a check issued to the City as payment for taxes, assessments, service fees, rentals, recovery of expenditures, etc., which is subsequently rejected for payment by a bank or other financial institution when presented for collection. A check may be dishonored for such reasons as insufficient funds, a closed account, or an improper signature. Excluded from this definition is a check in which payment has been stopped because of a duplicate payment. [Eff 10/31/2004] (Auth: ROH §2-4.2(b)) (Imp: ROH §2-4.2(b))
- §3-71-3 Dishonored Check Service Fee.**
A service fee shall be the amount specified in HRS 40-35.5. [Eff 10/31/2004; am 1/15/2010] (Auth: ROH §2-4.2(b)) (Imp: ROH §2-4.2(b))
