1. Call to Order

The meeting of the Grants in Aid (GIA) Advisory Commission (Commission) was called to order by Chair Kaipo Kukahiko (Chair) at 12:02 p.m. with five (5) Commissioners present.

2. Approval of Minutes: December 5, 2024 Meeting

Vice Chair Kagimoto moved to approve and file the minutes of the December 5, 2024 meeting. Commissioner Larsen seconded the motion.

There was no discussion and no objections or abstentions to this Motion. Thus, this motion was adopted unanimously.

3. Oral Testimonies and Written Testimonies from the Public

There was no written testimony.

Stephanie Thomas, Operations Manager from Common Grace provided oral testimony.

4. Presentation from the Department of Community Services (DCS): Report on the Periodic Review of the Grants in Aid Advisory Commission (“Commission”)

Mr. Akagi introduced Director Anton C. Krucky and Deputy Director Aedward Los Banos of the Department of Community Services. Director Krucky thanked the Commissioners for their volunteer work and allowing him to be a part of this meeting.

Mr. Akagi discussed the City Ordinance required periodic review of the Commission, which occurs every five (5) years. The GIA Advisory Commission was last reviewed in 2020. The submitted report mirrors the previous one but includes updated figures on expenditures, grants awarded, and amounts reviewed. Upon approval by the Commission, the report is to be signed by Chair Kukahiko and forwarded to the City Council via the Managing Director’s Office.

5. FOR DISCUSSION AND ACTION: Adoption of Report on the Periodic Review of the Commission

Vice Chair Kagimoto moved for the adoption of the Report on the Periodic Review of the Commission and Commissioner Larsen seconded the motion.

There was no discussion and no objections or abstentions to this Motion. Thus, this motion was adopted unanimously.

6. Testimony/Comments from Department/Agencies

a. - Presentation from the DCS for Fiscal Year (FY) 2026

i. Presentation of Score Variance, Variance Changes, and Adjustments

Mr. Akagi explained that the role of the GIA Advisory Commission is to score proposals and make recommendations to the City Council. The City Council has the final say on the funding of these proposals. He explained that the Commissioners score the proposals individually, and the scores are aggregated. He shared that variance occur when a score deviates by more

than 40% from the median, and this year, there were several variances, likely due to three (3) new Commission members.

Mr. Akagi presented the list of score variances and explained that the Commissioners have choices to review and adjust their scores or keep their scores unchanged. The Commission agreed to keep the scores as is and unchanged.

ii. Presentation of Proposal Scores (if no variances)

Mr. Akagi indicated that he is waiting for the revenue estimate before providing the proposal scores.

7. FOR DISCUSSION AND ACTION: FY2026 Grants in Aid Proposals – Score Variances, Variance Changes, and Adjustments; and

There are score variances, but all the Commission chose not to change any scores and to keep the scores as is. The Commission will not be making any changes or adjustments to the score variances.

Commissioner Larsen moved for the adoption of the Score Variances and Commissioner Haumschild seconded the motion.

There was no discussion and no objections or abstentions to this Motion. Thus, this motion was adopted unanimously.

8. FOR DISCUSSION AND ACTION (if any): FY2026 Grants in Aid Proposals – Adoption of Proposal Scores

As the proposal scores were not available, the proposal scores will be reviewed at the next Commission meeting.

9. FOR DISCUSSION AND ACTION: FY2026 Grants in Aid Proposals – General

Vice Chair Kagimoto raised the concern of the increasing number of proposal being reviewed by the Commissioners and the need to develop a process and possible simplification of information to work with this situation. After the submission to the City Council of the FY2026 report, the Commission should review this situation and discuss ways to make this process better.

Mr. Akagi informed the Commission that the City has not yet provided a revenue estimate, so the total funds available for the Grants in Aid program remain unknown. Since the cutoff point for funding depends on the receiving information on the available revenue estimate, Mr. Akagi suggested canceling the February 14, 2025 meeting and holding the next Commission meeting on Tuesday, February 18, 2025.

10. Next Meeting Date:

Based on the recommendation of DCS and to give DCS time to develop and

finalize for the Commission review and approval the Commission’s report and letter to the City Council, Chair stated that the Friday, February 14, 2025 Commission meeting is cancelled, and the next Commission meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, February 18, 2025 at 11:30 a.m.

This meeting will be held by video/interactive conference technology from remote locations via Zoom with the meeting ID posted on the Agenda, and an in-person location at Kapalama Hale.

11. Adjournment

Vice Chair Kagimoto moved to adjourn this meeting and Commissioner Sgan seconded. There was no discussion and no objections or abstentions to this Motion. Thus, this motion was adopted unanimously.

Chair adjourned the meeting at 12:37 p.m.

Pursuant to the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu 1973 (2017 Edition) Section 9-205, Article 52 Grants in Aid Fund, Chapter 6, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 2021, as amended ("ROH"), Resolution No. 20-263, CD1, and Resolution 24-118, the Grants in Aid Advisory Commission (Commission) hereby submits its Report with the attached 2025 Commission Resolution.

The Commission Resolution, signed by the Commissioners, includes lists of grant proposals recommended for funding by the Grants in Aid (GIA) Fund and complete lists of grant proposals scored by the Commission. Appendix 1 lists recommended grants by organization in alphabetical order, Appendix 2 lists recommended grants in score order, Appendix 3 lists all recommended grants grouped by City Council District (Council District). Appendix 4 lists all scored grant proposals by organization in alphabetical order, Appendix 5 lists all scored grant proposals in score order, and Appendix 6 lists the Commissioners' recusals from scoring. As clarification, the maximum score for Tier I proposals is forty-seven (47) points and the maximum score for Tier II proposals is one hundred and two (102) points. Also attached is an Executive Summary of all proposals submitted for the FY26 GIA fund and a copy of each proposal.

The Commission recommends to the City Council (Council) that should additional funding become available, then the one partially funded organization (Our Pasifika) should be funded up to their \$150,000 requested amount.

RECOMMENDED GRANT PROPOSALS TO BE FUNDED BY
MONIES FROM THE GRANTS IN AID FUND

WHEREAS, the Grants in Aid Advisory Commission (Commission) has been established pursuant to Section 9-205 of the Revised Charter of the City & County of Honolulu 1973 (2017 Edition), as amended (Charter), which is to advise the City and County of Honolulu (City) on the issuance of grants from the Grants in Aid Fund; and

WHEREAS, Article 52 was added to Chapter 6 of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, 2021, by Ordinance 13-7 (Bill 4 (2013), CD2, FD1) relating to the Grants in Aid Fund which provides that the Commission shall review applications for grants in aid monies from the Grants in Aid Fund consistent with the priorities established by the City Council of the City and County of Honolulu (Council) by resolution and amended by Ordinance 13-40 (Bill 55 (2013) FD1); and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance 13-7 further provides that, for grant proposals funded through the fiscal year 2026 budget, the deadline for the submission of applications shall be January 20, 2025, and that the Commission shall submit a report setting forth its recommendations to the Council by March 4, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 20-263, CD1 was adopted by the Council establishing City policies and priorities for the use of the Grants in Aid Fund, superseding in its entirety Resolution 17-201, on November 5, 2020 and Resolution 24-118 was adopted by the Council on August 7, 2024; and

WHEREAS, based on Charter Section 9-205, Ordinance 13-7, Ordinance 13-40, Resolution 20-263, CD1, and Resolution 24-118, the Commission has this day adopted a list of recommended grant proposals to be forwarded to the Council which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission as follows:

1. The list of recommended Tier I and Tier II grant proposals, shown in Appendix 1 (alphabetical order), Appendix 2 (score order), and Appendix 3 (grouped by council district order) attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, be and hereby are approved as the grant proposals to be funded by monies from the Grants in Aid Fund recommended to the Council by this Commission; and

2. The list of all grant proposals scored by this Commission, shown in Appendix 4 (alphabetical order) and Appendix 5 (score order) attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, be and hereby are determined to be all eligible grant proposals submitted to this Commission by January 20, 2025, and effectively scored according to methodology adopted by this Commission.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
