Disasters have inflicted significant property losses and resulted in death and injury to residents and visitors in the City and County of Honolulu (City). With our continuing growth and development, these threats can be expected to pose even greater risks to the safety and welfare of our people in the future.

The City and County of Honolulu is continually reassessing its capabilities to become proactive to its emergency management needs and to mitigate the effects of, rather than trying to recover from, the destruction of natural and human-caused hazards. The City is spearheading its mitigation approach in line with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 by coordinating planning efforts with federal, state, county, private, and corporate sectors of the community.

These aforementioned efforts have produced a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan outlining all of the strategies to reduce or eliminate loss of property or life caused by natural hazard events to the City. This plan will continue to address the risks, vulnerabilities, mitigation goals, mitigation projects, and enhance an updating mechanism to ensure this plan remains at the forefront of the City's hazard mitigation goals.

It is often said that an ounce of prevention equals a pound of cure; mitigation is that ounce, saving the City, its residents, its businesses and its visitors from the costly effects of the next disaster. In accordance with §322 of the Stafford Act, as amended by §104 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, this 2025 plan update is hereby adopted and implemented.
