- **Engage the Community and Provide Accessibility:** Expand the Garden's role as a community resource responsive to the needs of Ko'olaupoko residents.
- **Preserve Environmental, Cultural, and Historical Resources:** Acknowledge and integrating the cultural heritage of the 'āina and its historical significance in the Garden's future development.
- **Provide Botanical and Facility Development:** Plan for the future improvements and care of the diverse plant collections, garden infrastructure, public facilities, educational spaces, and visitor amenities.
