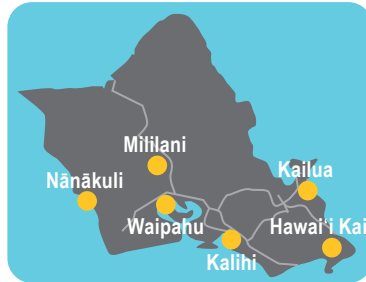


# INCLUDE THE FOOD!

## STARTING APRIL 1, 2026

If you received this mailer and/or live in the area of Waipahu, Nānākuli, Hawai'i Kai, Mililani, Kailua, or Kalihi, you can add food scraps and wasted food to your green compost cart starting April 1, 2026!

Composting diverts waste from the landfill, reduces methane gas emissions from decomposing food, and produces nutrient-rich compost to grow more plants on the island. Feed the green and G.R.O.W. the 'āina.



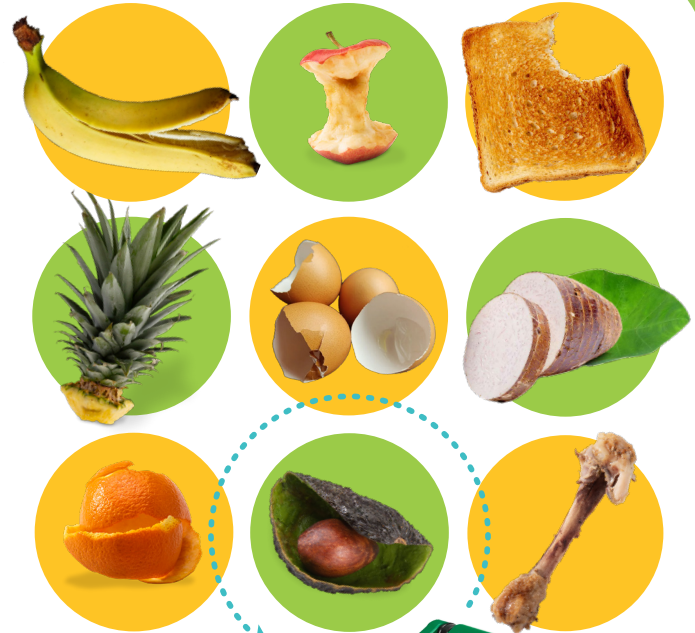
