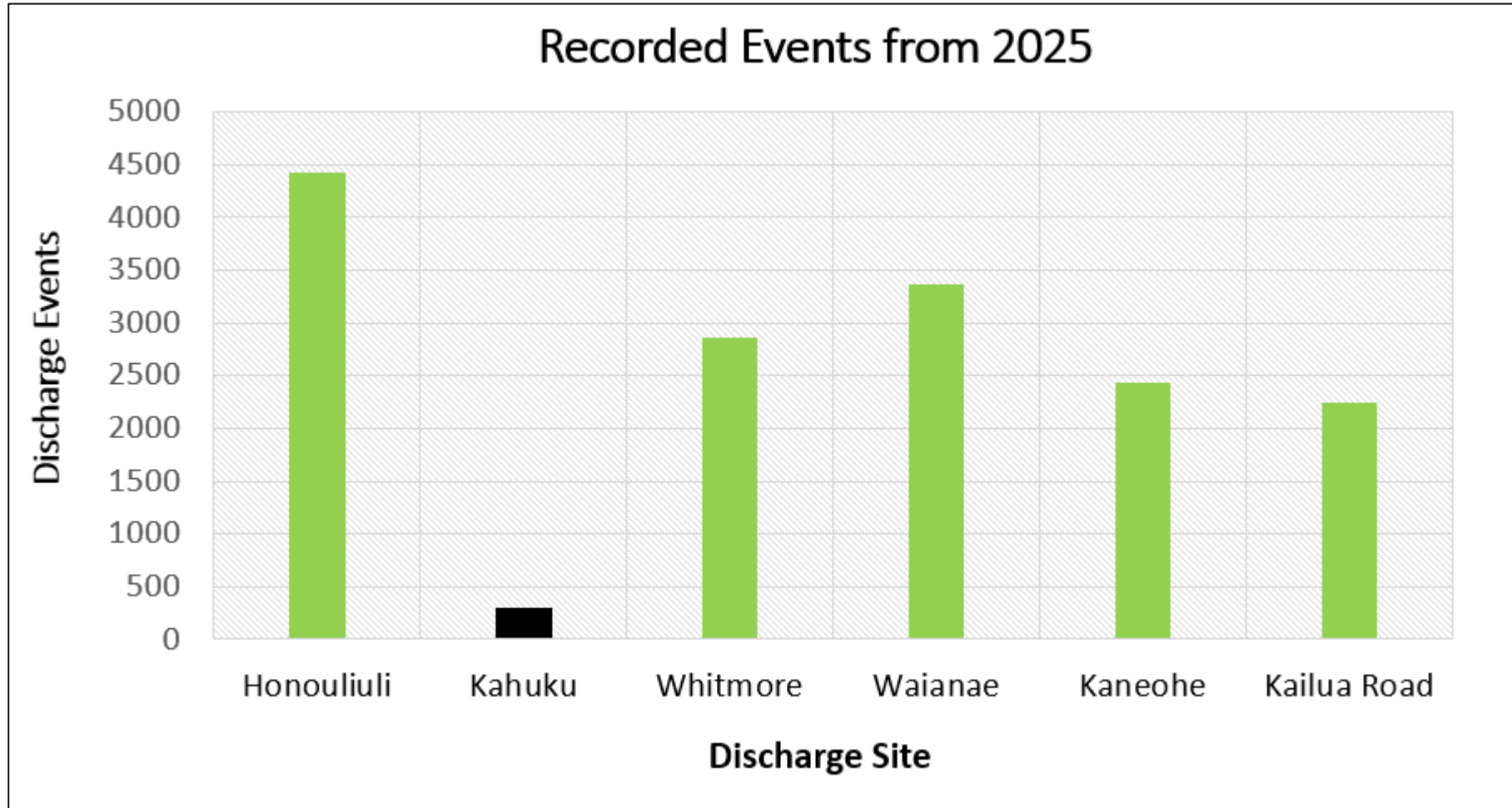

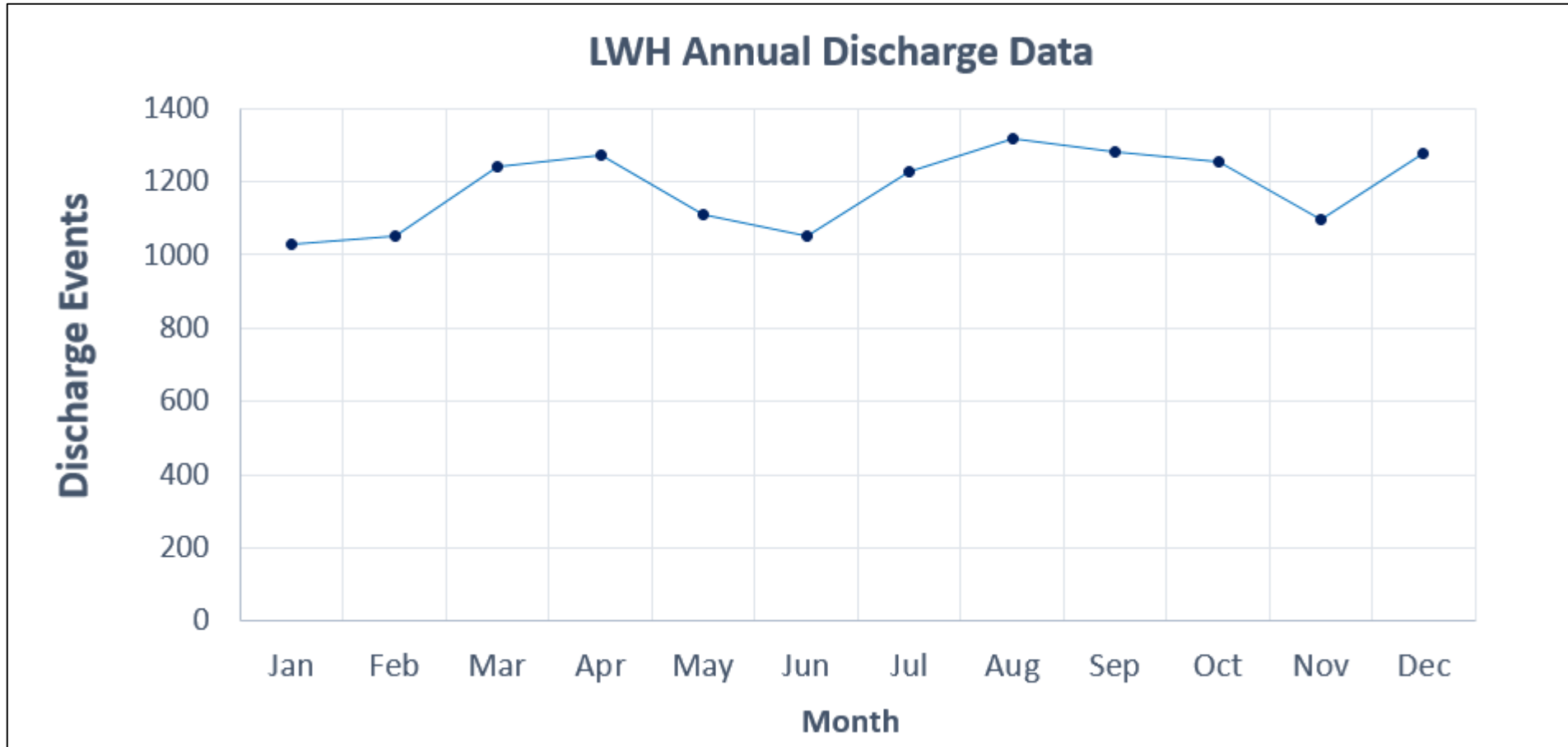

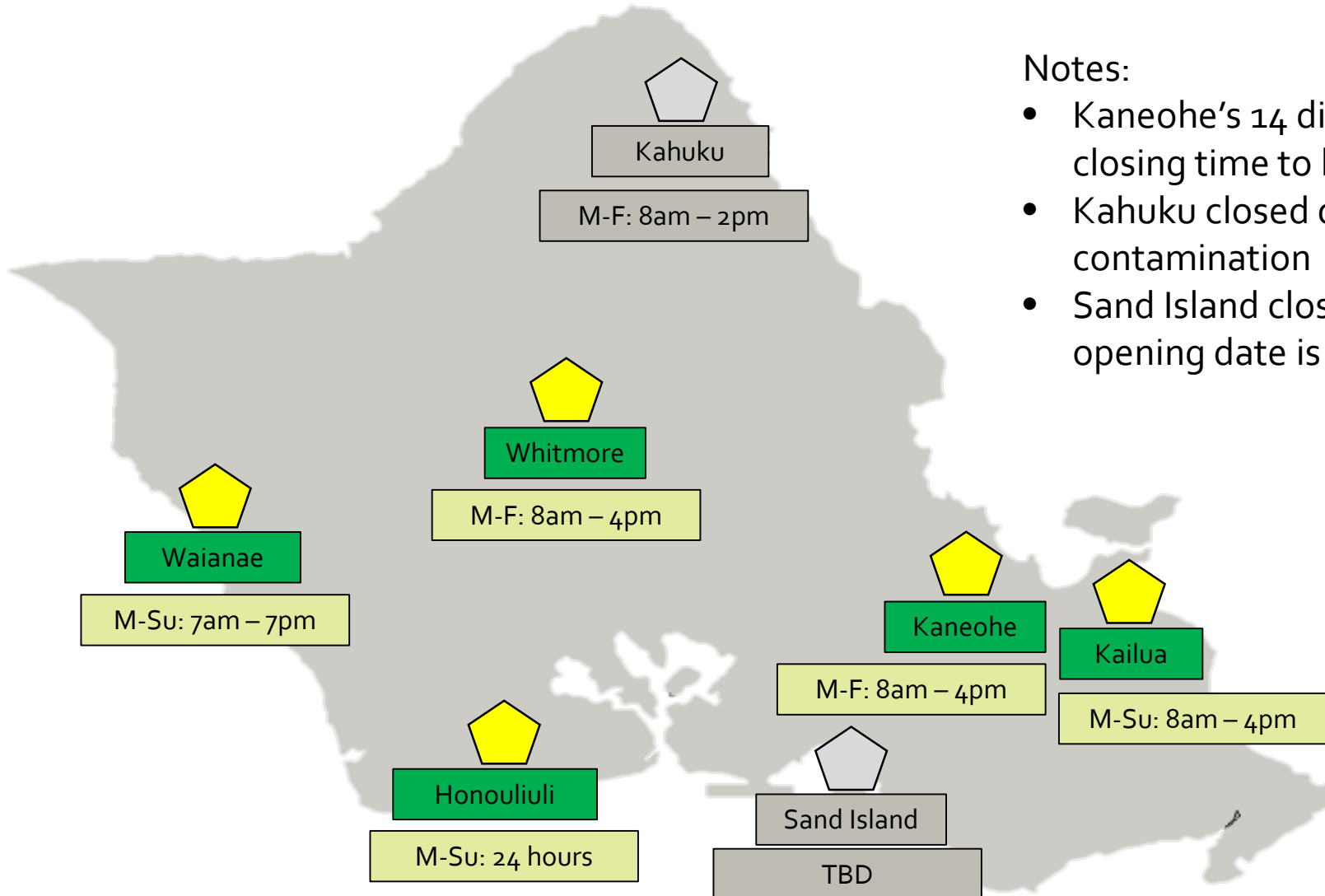
2025 Discharge Data: Site Usage

Whitmore PTF Update

- ENV received complaints relating to odor and increased vehicular traffic
- December 8, 2025 – ENV installed a suction blower which captures odors during discharges
- Please drive with caution and avoid running over the suction blower hose as you park your vehicle for discharge

Kahuku SHF Update

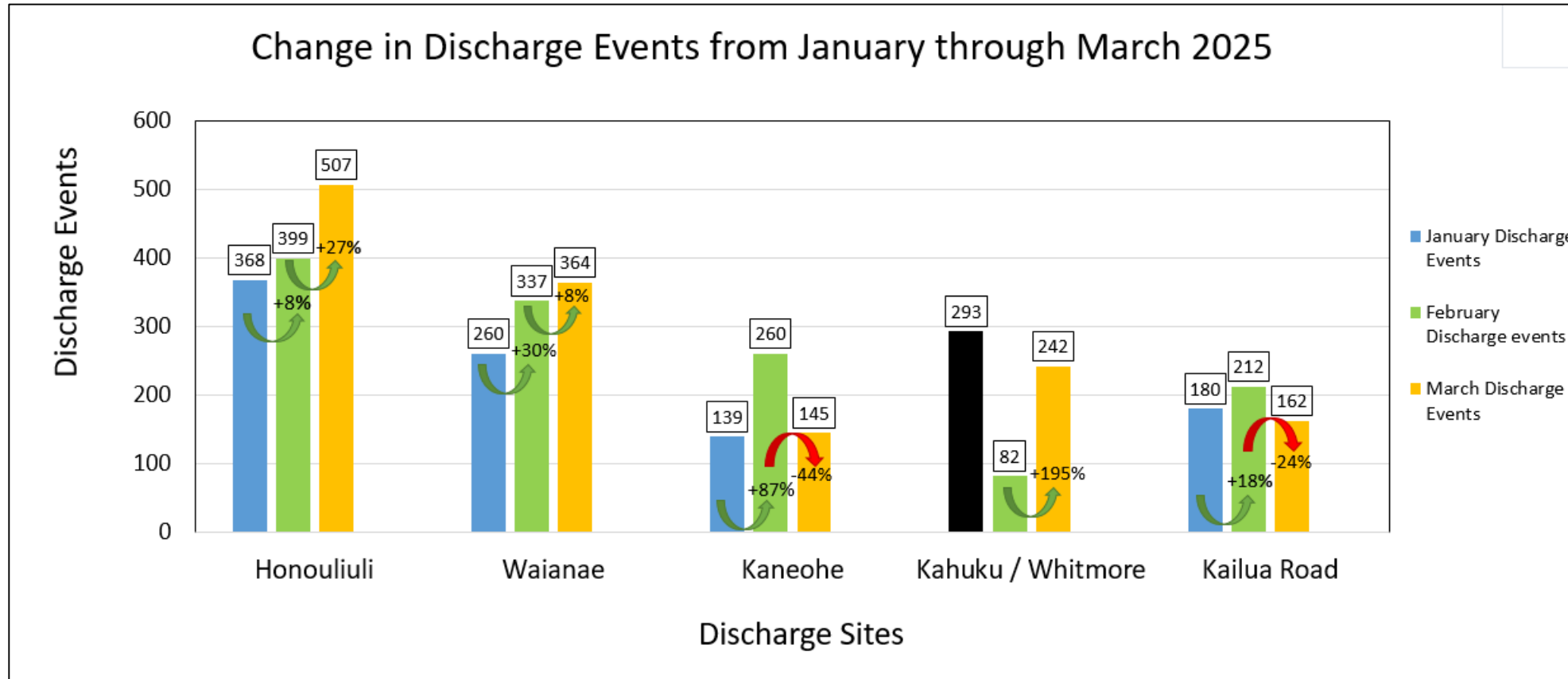
- Kahuku Septage Handling Facility is still closed until further notice
- ENV is in the process of mitigating the situation
 - Septage handling facility was rinsed of the contaminated load and wash water is to be disposed of
 - Tentative opening date is mid-March
- December 30, 2025 – ENV observed slug loads that negatively affect the biology of the WWTP. Kahuku is a small treatment plant. Any high strength loads can disrupt the treatment process



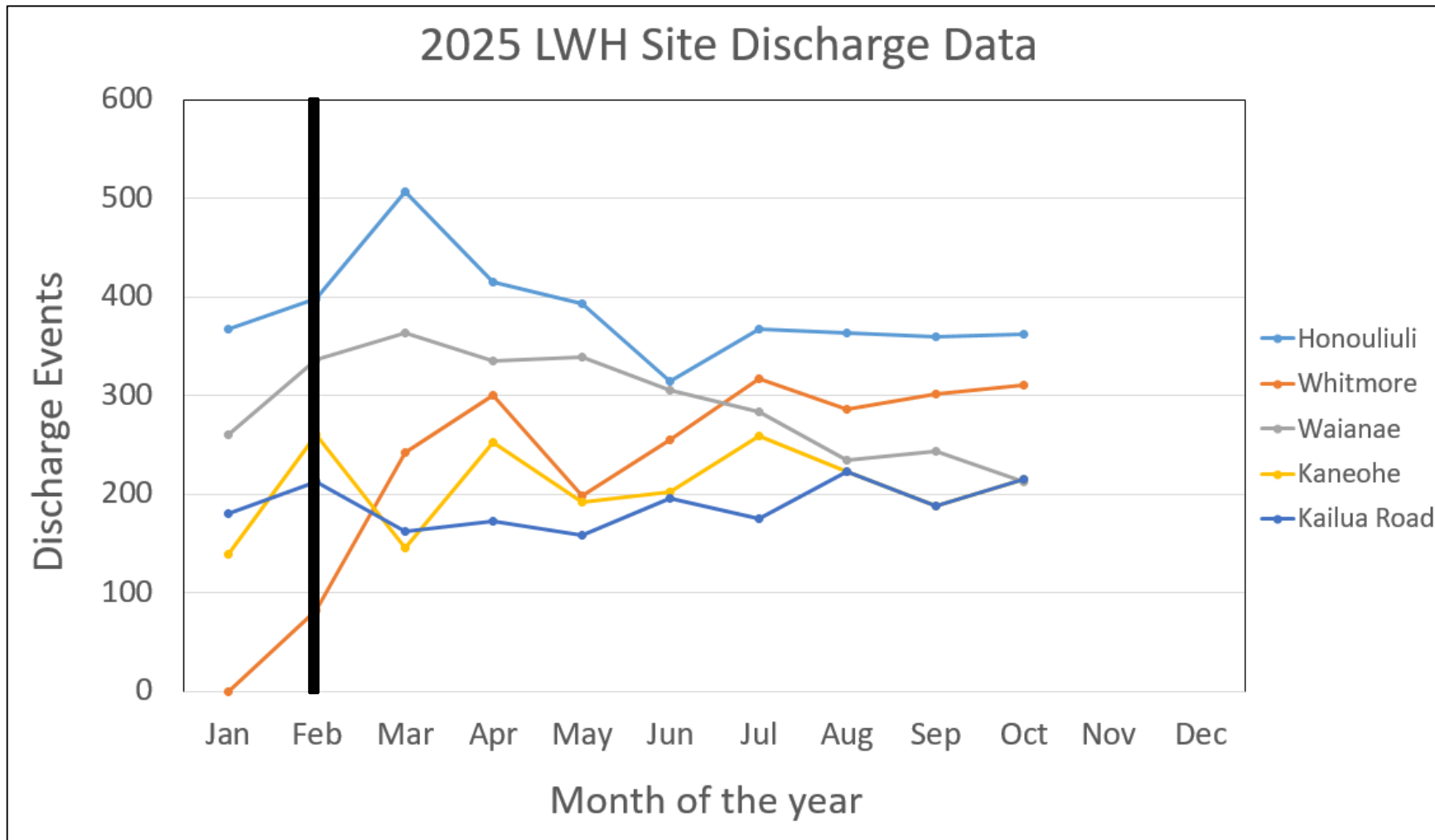
12/30/2025: Observed Slug load

Site Usage Following Kahuku's Closure



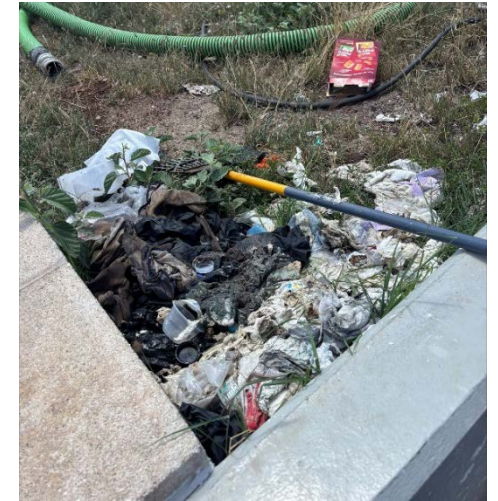
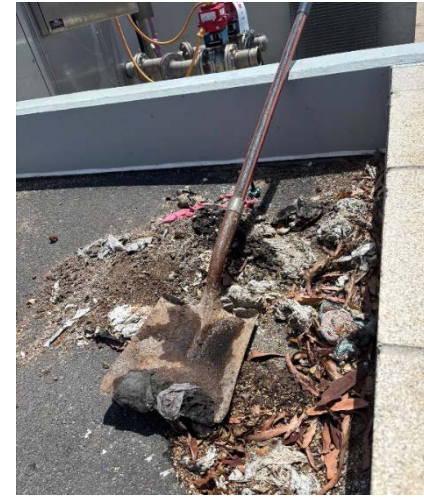
Impact of Kahuku's Closure

- Following Kahuku's closure, Honouliuli and Waianae initially experienced a surge in usage but have trended downwards throughout the year once Whitmore was opened
- Discharge sites closest to Kahuku (Whitmore, Kaneohe, and Kailua) increased in usage and experienced a steady or upward trend in usage throughout the year
- Kaneohe PTF reached its daily discharge limit more frequently with **55 early closures** in 2025 vs **4 early closures** in 2024



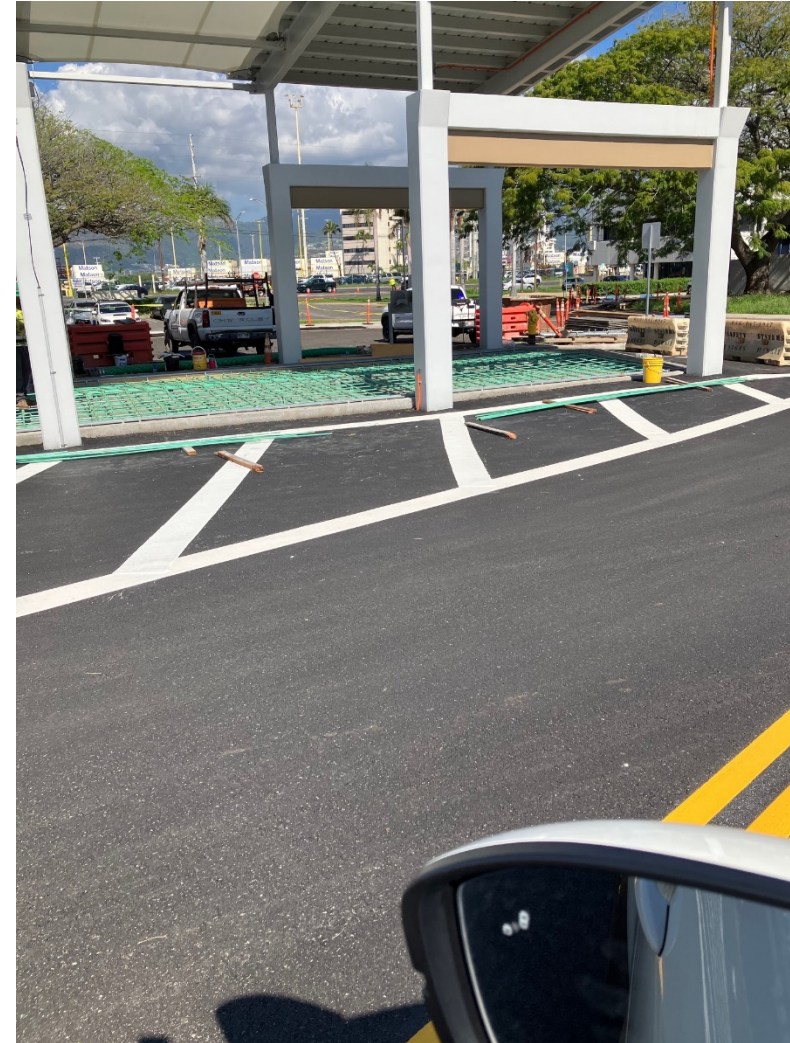
Honouliuli Updates

- November 7, 2025 – ENV continues to observe trash on the ground of the Honouliuli SRF
 - Any trash and solid waste must be cleaned up and properly disposed of offsite
 - To mitigate trash, ENV will monitor the location for litter
- February 4, 2026 – ENV mounted Honouliuli SRF Info banner on the fence near the station entrance



Sand Island Updates

- Designed discharge port height was 36", ENV has completed a change order to adjust the discharge the discharge port height to 28", same as Honouliuli, by adding an overlay to driveway
- Tentative opening date: September 2026

Kailua Road Updates

- December 26, 2025 – ENV discovered a 3" male cam lock at the Kailua Road Pump Station when cleaning pump debris
- January 5, 2026 – ENV provided notification to all type 1 haulers of accidental dropping of equipment into discharge sewer manhole
- If during your discharge, equipment (hoses, cam locks, pry bars, etc.) accidentally falls into the discharge sewer manhole, please notify ENV (808) 768-3263 and the security guard at the discharge site as soon as possible so we can effectively remove it from the system

Compliance Reminder

- ENV will issue appropriate enforcement to haulers found to be in violation of their industrial wastewater discharge permit (IWDP) general conditions, including the following:
 - Delinquent monthly reporting
 - Delinquent sewer fee payments
 - False reporting and/or issuing misinformation
 - Damage to ENV facilities
 - Unauthorized discharges
 - Failure to produce proper paperwork (DOH placard, manifests)
 - Falsification of reporting
- Type 1 haulers should only discharge wastewater which result from normal human living processes
- Familiarize yourself with your IWDP general conditions
- Be respectful of others and clean up after discharging
- Haulers should maintain a professional relationship with program managers, discharge site monitors, and facility staff



Delinquent Sewer Fee Payments as of December, 2025

- Total amount of delinquent sewer fees owed is **\$45,752.24**
- 8 out of 64 accounts have outstanding sewer fees
- ENV has been working with our billing department to collect outstanding balances from delinquent accounts



Notable Changes to General Permit

- Attachment D – Authorized Discharge Sites (Type 1 & 3)
 - Transferred from general permit condition to attachment for streamlined changes in the future for changes in discharge sites
 - General permit condition still references attachment
- Manifest (Type 1 & 3)
 - Revised manifest form implemented in June 2025
 - Ensure drivers are utilizing the most updated manifest form



Notable Changes to General Permit Continued....

- DOH Vehicle Placard (Type 1, 2 & 3)
 - ENV vehicle placard are no longer issued for new, renewal permits, and additional vehicles for existing permits.
 - Attachment A – Authorized Vehicles will still need to reflect additions and removals of vehicles
 - Haulers must have DOH-WWB, Registered Pumper and Hauler placard at all times in their vehicle
 - ENV will be working with DOH-WWB to ensure all vehicles are registered with them
- Attachment D – Barcode Requirements (Type 2)
 - Transferred from general permit condition to attachment for streamlined changes in the future
 - General permit condition still references attachment
- ENV will increase outreach to encourage clear communication
