

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Liquor Commission of the City and County of Honolulu will hold a public hearing in the hearings room of the Liquor Commission, Pacific Park Plaza Building, 711 Kapiolani Boulevard, Suite 600, Honolulu, Hawaii, on **Thursday, November 3, 2016, at 4:00 p.m.**, to consider the repeal of existing and the adoption of amended and new Rules of the Liquor Commission of the City and County of Honolulu.

The purpose of the proposed repealed, amended and new Rules is to address concerns of the Liquor Commission, the liquor industry, and the general public by repealing or clarifying existing Rules and creating new Rules relating to intoxicating liquor. The specific proposed repealed, amended and new Rules are summarized below:

**§3-80-1.1. Definitions.** Amends definition for “caterer” to conform with new class type; deletes definition of “stacking”; adds definition for “undue noise” or “undue disturbance” used in §3-84-78.03.

**§3-81-17.51. License Fees.** Adds license fees for new class type and newly-implemented classes; deletes license fee for repealed class.

**§3-81-17.54. Gross Sales Reports.** Makes conforming changes for newly-implemented class; clarifies report content and filing requirements; deletes reference to repealed class.

**§3-82-31.3. Determination of Nudity in Cabarets.;** **§3-82-31.5. Brew Pub Licenses.;** **§3-86-101.54. Minors on Licensed Premises with Nude Dancing.** Renumbering of section paragraphs only.

**§3-82-31.7. Catering [by Restaurant, Hotel, or Condominium Hotel Licensees].** Makes conforming changes to distinguish new class type; specifies food sales requirement for catered events.

**§3-82-31.8. Recorking.** Conforms Honolulu rule to Hawaii, Kauai, and Maui county liquor commission practice.

**§3-82-31.9. Catering by Food Service Businesses.** Implements new class type.

**§3-82-31.10. Winery Licenses.** Implements Class 16 license.

**§3-82-31.11. Manufacturer Licenses.** Authorizes Manufacturer licensees to charge for sampling.

**§3-82-38.4. Employee Records.** Makes conforming changes for newly-implemented classes.

**§3-82-38.5. Registration of Employees.** Makes conforming changes for newly-implemented classes; specifies required documents for certificates of registration.

**§3-82-38.8. Semi-Annual Submission of Employee List.** Reduces filing frequency to annual submission.

**§3-82-38.9. Licensee and Manager in Charge of Premises.** Makes conforming changes for newly-implemented classes; specifies required documents for manager registration.

**§3-82-38.12. Requirements of a Hotel License.;** **§3-82-38.24. Requirements of a Condominium Hotel License.** Deletes kitchen and dining room requirement to conform with statutory changes; clarifies requirements for off-premises catering.

**§3-82-38.19. Hours of Business.** Establishes hours of business for newly-implemented classes, sampling, and growler sales; deletes repealed license class.

**§3-82-38.27. “Growlers” or Containers used for Off-Premises Consumption.** Clarifies requirements as to acceptable containers used for “growler” sales.

**§3-82-41.4. Management or Operating Agreements.** Revises procedure for approval of management or operating agreements.

**§3-83-53.1. License Applications; Notice of Hearing; Affidavits.** Makes conforming changes for new class type and newly-implemented classes.

**§3-84-72.1. Sanitation Requirements.** Makes conforming changes for newly-implemented classes.

**§3-84-78.03. Entertainment.** Clarifies elements of rule violation.

**§3-84-78.52. Stacking of Drinks.** Repeal of rule.
