

NOTICE TO CONSULTANTS
REQUEST FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES

The City and County of Honolulu, Department of Transportation Services, is seeking a qualified Consultant for the COMPUTERIZED TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEM, PHASE 11 project. The intent of the project is to expand the area of the Traffic Control Center's Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) technologies to include the Kapolei area. Tasks shall include designing the plans, writing the technical specifications and getting the approvals needed to install the necessary infrastructure and equipment to operate a fully operational Computerized Traffic Control System in Kapolei.

The project is funded with 100% Federal Highway Administration funds and shall comply with all federal and State DOT requirements.

Qualified firms interested in being considered for the above contract are invited to submit their qualifications in accordance with the Guidelines for Preparing Consultant Qualifications for Traffic Signals and Technology Division Projects. In accordance with Section 103D-304, HRS, qualifications should include the following:

- (1) the name of the firm or person, the principal place of business, and location of all of its offices;
- (2) the age of the firm and its average number of employees over the past years;
- (3) the education, training, and qualifications of key members of the firm;
- (4) the names and phone numbers of up to five clients who may be contacted, including at least two for whom services were rendered during the preceding year; and
- (5) any promotional or descriptive literature which the firm desires to submit.
- (6) Federal Funds will be used for this project, therefore, the qualified firm may be required to submit DBE/WBE information.
