Pursuant to HRS §103D-306 and HAR Chapter 3-122, Subchapter 9, the Department requests sole source approval to purchase the following:

1. Description of goods, services, or construction to be procured:  
The Traffic Crash Reconstruction, Pedestrian/Bicycle Crash Investigation, and Advanced Pedestrian/Bicycle Crash Investigation classes are scheduled for 2015. These courses will provide the investigators with the necessary skills to conduct thorough traffic crash investigations and properly document their findings for courtroom presentation. Topics include an intense study of time/distance calculations, two-dimensional momentum and impact speed calculations, and the special dynamics involved in pedestrian and bicycle traffic crashes.

6. The good, service, or construction has the following unique features, characteristics, or capabilities:  
The Institute of Police Technology and Management (IPTM) has provided training for the Honolulu Police Department (HPD) and the three other counties in this state. They have the expertise involving the state of Hawaii's traffic patterns, geography, laws, and rules and regulations. This provides uniformity and consistency for traffic investigations. Training provided by the IPTM would be advantageous to the City and County of Honolulu due to their experience and familiarity with the HPD and its investigative practices. If another vendor is utilized, there will be inconsistencies with traffic investigations that would negatively impact the prosecution and defense of traffic collision cases. To be consistent with the training statewide, we request that the IPTM teach these courses.

7. How the unique features, characteristics, or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the agency?  
The IPTM brings expertise and consistency in educating investigators specifically based on Hawaii's traffic patterns, geography, laws, and rules and regulations. Standardization of the training is essential to ensure that the investigators/team members uniformly conduct at-scene investigations.

8. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services, or construction.  
Although there are other companies that provide traffic investigation training, they lack the knowledge and experience with Hawaii's traffic laws, regulations, and geography that the IPTM has. The IPTM has provided this training for the HPD and three other counties in this state.

9. Alternate source. Describe the other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction that were investigated but did not meet the agency needs.

The Northwestern University Center for Public Safety, North Carolina Justice Academy, and Butler Tech are some of the companies that offer crash investigation courses; however, they lack the knowledge and experience about the state of Hawaii's regulations, laws, and traffic patterns. Having the IPTM teach the course is in the best interest of the city due to the IPTM's knowledge, experience, and consistency in educating the HPD in traffic investigations.
