## **‘AIEA-PEARL CITY TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT** **COMMUNITY MEETING**

Honolulu City Councilmember Brandon Elefante of District 8, ‘Aiea-Pearl City-Waipahū, is inviting the public to a Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) Community Meeting that he’s sponsoring in partnership with the City Department of Planning and Permitting (DPP).

“The public’s input on these TOD rezoning plans are critical for envisioning and planning for these transformative areas,” said Councilmember Elefante. “We had a community meeting last year, and this second TOD meeting will illustrate how rail stations are going to integrate with our neighborhoods.”


DPP’s Community Building & TOD Administrator, Harrison Rue, will be at the meeting to show how the areas around the new rail stations will be revitalized with new opportunities for housing and mixed-use development. TOD will enable people to live closer to the rail stations, increase the affordable housing stock, and help landowners to redevelop their parcels. The ‘Aiea-Pearl City TOD covers the rail stations at Hālaulani (Leeward Community College), Waiawa (Pearl Highlands), and Kalauao (Pearlridge).

Following this community preview of the TOD area rezoning, a bill will be transmitted to the Planning Commission. Once the Planning Commission processes the ‘Aiea-Pearl City TOD rezoning with their own set of public hearings, the bill will come to the Honolulu City Council for action, sometime in 2020.

The ‘Aiea-Pearl City TOD community meeting takes place on Wednesday, September 18, 2019, from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm in the cafeteria at Lehua Elementary School, 791 Lehua Avenue. Doors open at 6:00 pm for attendees to sign in.
