

Consent For Release Of Criminal Conviction Records

Section 6(q) of the United States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437d(q)) authorizes Public Housing Agencies that administer Section 8 programs to obtain criminal conviction records from a law enforcement agency. The criminal conviction records are to be used to screen applicants / participants for eligibility to receive the program benefits. Under 24 CFR 5.902 and the City & County of Honolulu, Administrative Rules, Title 8, Chapter 10, Section 8-10-23, each adult household member is subject to this screening.

CONSENT: I consent to allow HUD or the HA to request and obtain information of any criminal convictions from a law enforcement agency for the purpose of screening for eligibility to receive benefits from the City & County of Honolulu Section 8 Rental Assistance Program.

All adult household members must complete and sign the consent form.
