Background

The City & County of Honolulu engaged PBR Hawaii & Associates, Inc. (PBR Hawaii) to conduct a business needs assessment survey of both employers and employees who work in the Airport, Mapunapuna, Pearl Harbor and Salt Lake areas (Airport Area). Employer and employee surveys were administered separately. This report summarizes the results of the *employee* survey.

The primary purpose of the employee survey was to gain a better understanding of employee needs and opinions on potential Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) in the area which can differ from employer needs. With this information, the Department of Planning & Permitting (DPP) will develop a TOD plan that responds to business needs in conjunction with input received from other community surveys and technical studies. Ultimately, the TOD plan will help guide future public investment and development around the rail stations including prioritizing City resources, revising regulations on land use, and informing urban design plans, transportation investment, and public facilities improvements.

Methodology

The Airport Area TOD Employee survey was developed jointly by the City & County of Honolulu Department of Planning & Permitting and PBR Hawaii, and closely resembles the separate employer survey developed by the National Research Center. The survey had questions about community amenities, issues, preferences, opinions, and other pertinent information to help assess employee needs in the Airport Area. The final survey form is provided in Appendix A.

The survey is not scientific in that survey respondents do not reflect a representative sample of the Airport Area employee population. While efforts were made to reach as many employees as possible, participation was limited to those with online capabilities and the survey was only provided in English.


PBR Hawaii administered the online survey from August 25 to November 3, 2014. The service used for the survey was SurveyMonkey.com. The survey was open to the general public (assuming they had internet access), however, valid responses were limited to people who worked in the Airport, Salt Lake, Mapunapuna, and Pearl Harbor areas (Airport Area).

A link to the online employee survey was included in the employer survey mailing which was sent to 1,001 businesses and emailed to larger employers of this group. The link was also sent to DPP's Airport Area TOD Plan Advisory Committee and they were asked to share the link with their colleagues and employees. To increase participation, \$50 Amazon.com gift cards were offered as a prize to ten randomly selected survey respondents.

To help increase the validity of the data collected through the online version of the survey, PBR Hawaii staff periodically reviewed collected data for signs of manipulation; that is, did employees or groups of employees collude to bias the survey results by taking the survey multiple times and answering specific questions that same way each time. Online survey tools allow collected data to be checked and suspect responses (or full surveys) to be identified. The final assessment of survey results differentiates between the full data set (pre-cleaning) and the valid data set (post-cleaning).

Survey Responses

A total of 159 employees responded to the survey, with a total of 126 respondents (79%) completing all 25 survey questions. Since this survey was intended to gain feedback from employees who work in the Airport Area (see map below), respondents who indicated a work location outside of this area was removed from the data set reducing the total amount of surveys to 151. The total number of responses for each question varies, since the survey format did not require respondents to answer a question before proceeding to the next question and some respondents chose to skip individual questions. All survey responses including open-ended comments and “Don’t Know” or “N/A” responses are provided in Appendix B. Appendix C highlights differences in responses based on the various employee work locations: Airport, Pearl Harbor, Mapunapuna, and Salt Lake.



Survey Highlights

This section provides an overview from the online survey and reveals six core findings.

Employees liked their location

- 49% liked that their work location was easy to access
- 48% have worked at their location for over 10 years—35% of that worked at their location for over 20 years
- 36% said it was very important and 33% said it was somewhat important that they were located close to the H1 Freeway

Employees largely relied on cars for transportation

- 97% drove their car (alone) to and from work
- 69% said that a lack of parking was a major issue

Poor traffic flow and extremely heavy traffic during peak hours caused negative impacts for employees before, during and after work

- 82% said delays in traffic flow (slow speed or poor flow) had a very negative to somewhat negative impact
- 24% said traffic flow on local streets was poor
- Survey respondents indicated that heavy traffic contributes to delay in work deliveries, missed appointments, increased travel times to and from work, tardiness in getting to work and picking up children after work

Walking and bus transit infrastructure rated more highly than features supporting bike travel

- The presence and condition of both sidewalks and bus stops rated mostly excellent or good
- Safety while biking and the presence of bike paths/lanes and bike racks/storage rated poor

Most employees said that rail transit will have a positive effect on their daily work routine but will not likely use it in the future

- 41% said that the new rail stations will have a positive impact on their daily work routine and 40% said no impact
- 61% said that it is somewhat to very unlikely that they would use rail transit

Employees were supportive of redevelopment efforts and a variety of potential amenities near their workplace and rail stations


- 76% said they support redevelopment efforts (only 4% strongly oppose)
- More restaurants (96%) and coffee, tea and smoothie shops (90%) are desired
- Amenities for car users such as gas stations (87%) and convenience stores (86%) are desired
- Most wanted to see improved lighting in public spaces (91%) and more trees and landscaping (89%)

Who We Heard From


Overall completed surveys were received from 151 employees that were identified as being in the target area. The majority (62%) worked in the Airport area, 20% in the Mapunapuna area, 15% in Salt Lake, and 4% in Pearl Harbor area. About 40% of those completing the survey worked for organizations that provided services, one-quarter were in retail or sales, and the rest were in government, education, construction, and manufacturing.

Most employees (31%) have been working at their current job location for 10 to 19 years. While not the majority, a significant amount of people (17%) have been working at their current location for more than 20 years. The majority of respondents are employed full-time. Only 3% work part time and no one indicated that they have a compressed work week.


Q1: In which area do you work?




Q21: How often do you work?




Q22: Which of the following best describes your job? (Check all that apply)



What We Heard

Best things about work location

Employees were asked what they liked the most about working at their location. They could choose from a list or write in a response if their favorite things were not on the list. Most said ease of access and having lots of places to eat. About one-quarter said they liked their work location because it was close to home. Others indicated that it was safe to walk or drive (few accidents). Many open-ended responses indicated that respondents liked the location of their jobs because it was centrally located, near the freeway, not in downtown but still convenient, and close to the Airport.


Q3: What do you like MOST about working in your area? (Check all that apply)



Difficulties about work location

Conversely, employees were asked what they liked least about their work locations. The most common complaint was that the area was far from home (42%), too noisy (28%), and not a lot of food establishments (24%). Respondents seem to be split when it comes to the number of food establishments, 29% say that there are lots of places to eat versus 24% who say there are not enough places to eat. The majority of open-ended responses indicated that traffic was the least liked attribute.

Ratings of Neighborhood Characteristics


Employees were asked to rate characteristics related to infrastructure and transportation mobility in the area near their business location.

The top rated characteristics were the presence of sidewalks, safety during the day, condition of sidewalks, presence of bus stops, frequency of buses for routes servicing the area, presence of crosswalks/crossing-lights, and cleanliness of public spaces.

The presence of sidewalks was rated as excellent and good by 21% and 49%, respectively, and the condition of sidewalks as rated excellent and good by 11% and 47%. Overall safety during the day was also rated as excellent or good by the majority (only 1% said this was poor), while safety during the night was rated as mostly poor (39%) or fair (40%).

Bicycle infrastructure received the worst ratings; 68% said the availability of bike racks was poor, 52% said the presence of bike paths and lanes were poor, and 51% rated safety while biking as poor.

Important Landmarks for Preservation

Employees were asked to answer in their own words, the question “What landmarks or features surrounding your workplace are most important to preserve?” Their responses were examined and generated into a word cloud below. A complete list of responses is provided in Appendix B. More employees wish to preserve natural and open space landmarks versus built, man-made structures. Most employees indicated that Keehi Lagoon Park, existing trees, mauka-makai views, and green open space are most important to preserve. Some of the noted man-made structures included the Airport, Pearl Harbor, Assets School, golf course, Lynch Field, Fire Fighters Training Center, and Arizona Memorial.

Areas for Improvement

Employees were also asked to write, in their own words, what one thing they would do to improve the area surrounding their workplace. Their responses were examined and generated into a word cloud below. A complete list of responses is provided in Appendix B. Most employees commented on transportation and mobility issues. The majority of employees wish to improve parking, traffic, and lighting. Comments regarding parking were aimed at increasing the number of parking stalls on and off-street. Traffic comments were mainly focused on improving traffic flow especially during the afternoon hours by calibrating the timing of traffic lights.

Q6: If there was one thing you could do to improve the area surrounding your workplace what would it be?




Issues and Negative Impacts

When asked if any potential issues have had a negative impact on their work environment, overall employees said that delays in traffic flow (slow speed or poor flow) (82%) and homelessness (82%) had a very negative to somewhat negative impact. Lack of parking (38%) and vandalism (30%) had a very negative impact.

Over half of respondents said that flooding, vacant buildings/stores and lack of connectivity (i.e. one way streets/dead ends) had no impact on their work environment, and closer to two-thirds said that having poor or no bus routes and cost of parking had no impact on their work environment.

Respondents were asked to elaborate on any of the issues and how it impacted them. The majority of comments were specific to delays in traffic, lack of parking, and homelessness. Although not rated as having a very negative impact by most, there were several comments about unwanted odors and flooding. These comments were mostly made by employees who work in the Mapunapuna area.

Q8: If the issues above occur near your workplace, how does it impact you?


Based on the responses to the list of potential issues, employees were asked how it impacted them. Some of the negative impacts included:

- Lack of Parking
 - “Conflicts and spats, including double parking and towing.”
 - “Patients leave or miss appointments when they cannot find parking.”
 - “Customers are not able to come and go freely from our establishment”
 - “Many times they will squeeze into a space that will partially block entrances and driveways”
- Unwanted Odors
 - “Unpleasant odors from the mauka winds causes people to not want to step outside of the office for fresh air.”
 - “When you come off the freeway to viaduct area, it does have a bad odor.”
- Flooding
 - “Difficult for me to drive through the roads (on Ahua).”
 - “Get flooded out and water corrodes car”
- Delays in Traffic
 - “Traffic is congested in the morning due to all the schools starting around the same time.”
 - “High container truck traffic makes traveling difficult and the lack of parking makes it difficult for recruiting.”
 - “Traffic is always backed up on Nimitz causing excessive time to get to/from job related activities”
- Homelessness
 - “Homelessness is a problem due to those in need stealing from companies.”
 - “Almost hit a homeless person nearby my work”
 - “Homeless use the bathroom all over and make it smell”

Proximity to Major Destinations and Thoroughfares

Probably related to the high degree of satisfaction with the location of their work place, most respondents said that being near the H1 Freeway (69%) and the Honolulu International Airport (49%) was somewhat or very important.

Question 10: Is It important to you that you work close to the following?




Daily Transportation


The majority of employees (97%) rely heavily on their cars (drive alone) to get to and from work. Twelve percent carpool or get dropped off on most days, and 29% carpool some of the time. Only 4% ride the bus regularly. Walking to and from work (13%) was more popular than biking (7%).

Only 20% of employees pick up or drop off children or family members on their way to work daily.

Q11: How often do you use the following modes of transportation to get to your workplace?




Q24: Do you pick up or drop off children/family members on your way to work?



Parking Availability

Free parking was very common in the area, and most employees had access to a combination of free parking spaces in lots and on the street. However, some employees did have to pay for parking.

Q13: What kind of parking is available to you for work? (Check all that apply)



Accessibility

Most employees do not require barrier free access for their mobility. However, it is important to note that more than 1 out of every 10 employees do require barrier free access.


Question 12: Do you require barrier free access for your mobility?



Keehi Lagoon Beach Park Use & Improvements

The majority of employees (63%) said that they never used Keehi Lagoon Beach Park. One-quarter indicated that they used the park once a month or less. When asked to indicate, in their own words, what single improvement they would make to the park, the majority of respondents said to address the homeless problem at the park. The next most requested improvement was to increase maintenance of the park facilities and keep it cleaner. The responses are shown in a word cloud below.

Q15: If you could make an improvement to Keehi Lagoon Beach Park, what would it be?




Rail Transit


The majority (61%) said that it is somewhat to very unlikely that they would use rail transit. For those who indicated that they would ride rail transit, the majority (52%) said that they would most likely use the Airport Station. Others said Lagoon Drive Station (31%), Pearl Harbor Station (10%), Stadium (5%), and Middle Street (2%).

Although the majority of respondents will not use rail transit to get to and from work, most respondents said that they expect the new rail stations to have a positive effect on their daily work routine. Only 18% said that it will have a negative effect, and 40% said no effect.


Q16: At least one rail station will be within 1-2 miles of your workplace. Once it is built, how likely or unlikely will you be to use rail transit to/from work?

Q18: Do you expect the new rail stations to have a positive effect, a negative effect, or no effect on your daily work routine?




Redevelopment Opportunities

Employees strongly support (38%) and somewhat support (38%) redevelopment efforts in the area surrounding their workplace.


The types of new businesses that employees said they strongly need are restaurants (37%), gas stations (32%), coffee, tea and smoothie shops (27%), recreational/sports facilities (gyms) (26%), and convenience stores (24%). While it is not strongly needed, over half of employees would like more drug stores (pharmacies) (66%) and grocery stores (64%) near their workplace. The majority expressed that they do not want bars or night clubs (84%) as part of the redevelopment effort. Other types of businesses that are not desired include hotels (59%), schools (55%), and beauty salons, hair dressers, manicurists, and cosmetologists (55%).

If new development or redevelopment occurred near their workplace and/or the rail stations, the features that most employees strongly want to include are improved lighting in public spaces (58%), traffic flow improvements (58%), more trees and landscaping (52%), and more parking facilities (52%). Features that are somewhat wanted are improved bus service (44%), new parks or plazas (42%), better bike lanes or paths (41%), and better building facades or exterior improvements (40%). Employees said that higher building heights (84%) and higher building densities (more buildings) (80%) are not important.


Q20: How strongly do you support or oppose redevelopment efforts in the area surrounding your workplace?


