**Kāneʻohe District Park’s pool closure extended**

Kāneʻohe – The Kāneʻohe District Park swimming pool will continue to be closed until Monday, September 19, 2016 as the pool is tested to ensure safe water quality.

Problems with the new pool pump’s manufacturer wiring resulted in the extended closure. The pump is now operational, but the delay pushed back other cleaning and water quality testing which is currently being conducted.

Repairs to the pool’s circulation system began on August 15, 2016. That included installing a new pump, upgrading the pipes that connect the pump to the pool and training pool staff concerning the new system.

We apologize for the inconvenience this poses to regular pool users and the general public. If the pool can be opened prior to that date, the public and regular pool users will be notified.
