



ADDENDUM TO PARADE/SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT FOR

1. INDEMNIFICATION

_____ (HEREINAFTER "applicant") agrees to defend, hold harmless and indemnify the CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU (hereinafter "CITY"), its officers, agents, and employees from and against all claims or demands for damages, including claims for loss of life, personal injury or wrongful death and/or damage to property arising from this Parade/Special Event Permit or growing out of or caused by any failure on the part of the APPLICANT to maintain the premises in a safe condition, and in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Parade/Special Event Permit. In case the CITY shall, without fault on its part, be made a party to any litigation commenced by or against the APPLICANT, then the APPLICANT shall protect and hold the CITY harmless and shall pay all costs, expenses and reasonable attorney's fees incurred or paid by the CITY in connection with such litigation.

This provision is in addition to, but not a substitute for, nor a limitation of, the hold harmless clause contained in the Parade/special Event Permit.

2. INSURANCE

A. The APPLICANT shall, concurrently with the approval of this Parade/Special Event Permit, procure at their own expense, the following insurance coverages:

(1) General Liability (Comprehensive form) Insurance covering, bodily injury, including death, personal injury and property damage, with limits of not less than \$500,000 Combined Single Limit per occurrence, and including the following supplemental coverages or endorsements:

(a). If alcoholic beverages are to be sold or served, Liquor Liability, with limits of not less than \$500,000 CSL per occurrence;

(b). If food or food products are to be sold or served, Products Liability, with annual aggregate limits of not less than \$500,000.

(2) Workers Compensation insurance, as required by State statutes, covering APPLICANT'S employees and volunteers working in any capacity in connection with the Parade/Special Event Permit.

B. All insurance required above shall name the City as an additional insured.

C. copies of, or certificates of insurance shall be filed through the

Director of the Department of Transportation Services with the Director of the Department of Finance; such policies shall contain a clause whereby the insurance company agrees to give notice in writing through the Director of the Department of Transportation Services to the Director of Finance of any cancellation or alteration of such policies at least ten (10) days prior to such cancellation or alteration.
