## NO DUMPING



Anyone who purposely removes manhole covers is in violation of Revised Ordinance of Honolulu (**Sec. 14-1.9b**) and subject to fines and/or imprisonment (**Sec 14-5.19 a & b**). Dumping rocks, yard waste, toys, lumber, metals, tricycle, tree limbs, etc is an act of vandalism punishable by law. Furthermore, those actions cause blockages resulting in wastewater spills that can adversely impact public health and the environment.

Spill response and mitigative actions are costly to the City and can eventually increase sewer fees to you, the rate payer. Only permitted dischargers and City personnel or their agents are allowed to open wastewater system manholes.
