



RESOLUTION

CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF MS. RIKI MAY AMANO TO SERVE ON THE ETHICS COMMISSION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

WHEREAS, Section 11-107 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu, 1973 ("Charter"), as amended, establishes an Ethics Commission ("Commission") comprised of seven members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council to five-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has the basic duties of rendering advisory opinions and conducting investigations concerning the application of the standards of ethical conduct of the City and recommending appropriate disciplinary action against city officers and employees who violate the standards; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-107 of the Charter prohibits members of the Commission from taking an active part in political management or in political campaigns; and

WHEREAS, by Mayor's Letter, dated February 28, 2019, the Mayor has reappointed Ms. Riki May Amano to serve as a member of the Ethics Commission; and

WHEREAS, if confirmed by the Council, Ms. Amano will serve for a term to expire on December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Section 13-103 of the Charter requires a Commission member to be a registered voter of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the qualifications and character of Ms. Amano and finds that she meets the requirements to serve on the Commission and deserves confirmation for reappointment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that this body confirms the reappointment of Ms. Riki May Amano to the Ethics Commission to serve for a term to expire on December 31, 2023; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to Ms. Amano for her commitment and willingness to continue serving the City and County of Honolulu; and


